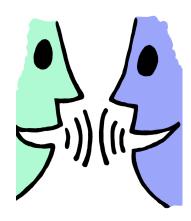

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## More about these workshops

### 1 Raising funds for your group

Where to get funding—some of the top funders for small community groups; what funders want to know about your group—giving your group the best change of a positive result when you apply for money; having a go at doing an application form some dos and don'ts; planning ahead to keep the money coming in so you don't suddenly go short.



## 2 How do you know if things are working?

What will your funders want to see?; how do you keep the right records of what your group is doing (monitoring) and then reif they are happy (evaluating)?

#### 3 Getting more people involved in your group and attracting volunteers

What are you offering that will attract people to your group to take part in your activities or volunteer to help?; what methods can you use to let people know about you, including social media; what is a communications and marketing strategy and why might it be useful to have one; how do you learn port back so they can decide from your experiences so that you group keeps getting better?
